

# MARICOPA COUNTY AIR QUALITY DEPARTMENT (MCAQD)

The Maricopa County Air Quality Department is the regulatory agency that controls air pollution in Maricopa County, Arizona. The MCAQD Planning and Analysis Division drafts air pollution regulations to control VOC emissions from stationary sources in the county and revises them as necessary to comply with the Clean Air Act. Rule 335 is the rule limiting the VOC content of architectural and industrial maintenance coatings.

## MCAQD AIM RULE EXEMPTIONS:

- Small container exemption allows the sale of coatings above maximum VOC limits if packaged in containers of one quart or less.
