A Building Renewal™ Solvent for Every Project

There are many different kinds of solvents, each performing a specific function with a specific product. And because paint thinners and solvents come in so many forms, it's essential to choose the right one for your paint product.

Below is a list of thinners and solvents available through the PPG *Building Renewal* Program. These solvents are recommended for use with the PPG *Building Renewal* primers, air barriers and topcoats. Use the same product for cleaning equipment and for spills. Not all paints will need to be thinned, so before proceeding with the thinning process, refer to the product technical data bulletin for recommendations. Keep in mind that thinning may be necessary when using a sprayer to apply paint.
